Program title	Italy for explorers
Program duration	3-4 weeks. The program can be shorter or joined to other University programs, according to the needs of the partner institution.
Educational objectives	To transform prior academic knowledge and concepts into a real life experience, thus 'living' in a foreign country as a local.
Key words	Countryside economy, local stakeholders, rural landscape, world heritage cities, everyday life, hands on activities, history, National Parks, participation in community services.

Program description		Study tours through different Italian regions, cities of culture and rural areas. Hands on activities according to educational programs, visits to relevant historical heritage sites, meetings with local key persons (academics, experts, decision makers, and locals) and direct contact with everyday life. Visit excavations in archaeological sites, art cities and sites under restoration; walking/hiking tours; organic farms, wine farms and crop harvesting; landscape interpretation on the field; visits to
		National Parks and meetings with their prominent professionals, workers and stakeholders; visits to artisans' workshops, and many other off-road opportunities to get to know real Italian life. Professors and students are hosted in comfortable guesthouses, situated in historical buildings.
